EVENT DETAILS

- 1) Players start with 30,000 in tournament chips.
- 2) Day 1, levels change every 25 minutes. Day 2, levels change every 40 minutes.
- 3) Late registration and re-entries are allowed until the start of level 11. No Refunds.
- 4) Re-entries take priority over alternates.
- 5) A single ante will be paid from the Big Blind for the entire table. The ante is posted prior to the Big Blind.
- 6) Day 2 is Sunday, Nov 24th @ 12:15 PM and will play to a winner at Live! Casino & Hotel Philadelphia.
